Dear Mr. Babbage:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Your letter has been referred to this office for reply relative to the burial of your son, the late Second Lieutenant Westmoreland Babbage.

It is regretted to have to advise you that, up to the present time, information pertaining to the burial of the remains of your son has not been received in this office. An inquiry is being made to ascertain information regarding the remains of all our deceased military personnel where burial information has not been received. Upon completion of this inquiry you will be advised as to the results.

In view of the fact that there is before the Congress legislation which will permit the repatriation of all American dead who have lost their lives while serving overseas, the War Department does not contemplate the sponsoring of pilgrimages to the American Cemeteries abroad. It is contemplated returning the remains of our deceased military personnel to the United States for final internment. At the proper time the legal next of kin will be contacted by this office in order to obtain their wishes regarding the final disposition of the remains.

This office regrets, sincerely, the delay in answering your letter and wishes to extend its deepest sympathy in the loss of your son.
