Dear Mr. & Mrs. Zygiel:

The Department of the Army desires that you be given the most recent information concerning your son, the late Staff Sergeant Leonard A. Zygiel, ASN 36 582 062.

The American Graves Registration Service in their search for deceased American personnel recovered certain remains from the area in which your son and his comrade met their death. As individual identifications could not be established at the time of the recovery, unknown designations were assigned pending further investigation, and temporary interments were made in a United States Military Cemetery overseas.

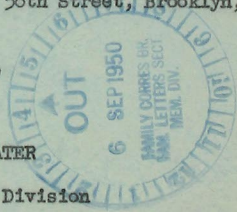
The investigation has now been completed and it has been impossible to individually identify your son's remains. It has been established, however, that the remains recovered are the only recoverable remains of your son and the comrade with whom he lost his life. This group of remains are now casketed, and being held overseas, pending return to the United States for interment in Ft. McPherson National Cemetery, located at Maxwell, Nebraska.

This plan for the burial in one of our country's shrines of all the known groups of men for whom individual identity cannot be established, is based upon the provisions of Public Law 383, 79th Congress as amended by Section 3, Public Law 368, 80th Congress. It is fitting and proper that our honored dead be interred in a national cemetery in the United States where perpetual care will be given the graves. This particular national cemetery was selected in order that no undue burden of travel might be placed on any one family wishing to attend the services.

You and the next of kin of the other man will be informed of the date and time of final interment sufficiently in advance to permit you and any interested persons to attend the ceremonies. In order that you may receive information concerning these final rites it is essential, in case you change your address, that you promptly inform the Commanding General, New York Port of Embarkation, Attention PQMD, First Avenue and 58th Street, Brooklyn, New York.

SUBJECT: Report of Death

1. The following named officer and enlisted men, Air Corps, members of the 671st Bombardment Squadron, 416th Bombardment Group, were reported missing in action, in flying pay status, over Germany on 29 September 1944, by ETO Ship-ment Number 217, and presumed dead as of 30 September 1945 under the provisions of Section 5, Missing Persons Act (SR&D Cs. No. 4154):

2. Missing Air Crew Report No. 9276, dated 2 October 1944, reveals that the subject persons constituted the crew of a A-20 (Havoc) bomber, aircraft number 43-9925, which departed its base at Melun, France on a bombardment mission to Julich, Germany on 29 September 1944. No information is available in the Report as to the fate of the crew and the plane.

3. Captured German record of the 35th Flak Regiment (mot), dated 30 September 1944, reports the downing of a U.S. type Boston plane at 1733 hours on 29 September 1944, 800 meters (.49 of a mile) southwest of Durboslar, Germany. The report indicates that the plane "crashed on fire, exploded," and the fate of the crew as "dead."

4. The Memorial Division, Office of the Quartermaster General has no burial reports on this crew at the present time.

a. The 293 file of S Sgt Arthur J. Burgess, 33416564, one of the subject crew, on file in the Memorial Division, OQMG, contains a letter from Headquarters, American Graves Registration Command, European Area, dated 27 July 1948, which states that the remains of Sergeant Burgess may be associated with the Unknown X-93 (Margraten E-4-83). The aircraft crashed about one kilometer (.62 of a mile) from Durboslar, Germany and the identification tag of S Sgt Leonard A. Zygiel, another crew member, was found in the wreckage. The remains of four Unknowns X-2501, X-2502 and X-2503 Neuville-en-Condroz and Unknown X-93 Margraten were recovered from Durboslar, Germany.

5. The subject persons were members of the crew of a A-20 (Boston or Havoc) bomber which departed its base at Melun, France on a bombing mission to Julich, Germany on 29 September 1944. The plane was believed to have been lost due to enemy antiaircraft fire in the target area. Captured German record of the 35th Flak Regiment reports the downing of a Boston type plane at 1733 hours on 29 September 1944 about one half mile southwest of Durboslar, Germany. The report indicates that the plane crashed on fire and exploded. The crew was reported as dead. The American Graves Registration Service located the wreck of a plane about one kilometer from Durboslar and found the identification tag of

one of the subject crew members in the wreckage. The remains of four unidentified persons were recovered from Durboslar. Considering the above facts, and the lapse of time, it is reasonable to believe that the subject persons were killed when their plane crashed.

6. It is recommended, therefore, that pursuant to the provisions of Section 9, Missing Persons Act, the foregoing information be accepted as an official report of death, and that a casualty report be initiated stating that the persons named in paragraph 1, above, were killed in action, in flying pay status, on 29 September 1944, when their plane crashed about one half mile southwest of Durboslar, Germany. The systemat will be processed in accordance with Paragraph 2b, Operations Bulletin 35, 1945. The casualty report and official report of death will include the following statement:

This "Report of Death" is issued in accordance with Section 9 of said Act and its effect on prior payments and settlements is as provided in Section 9.
