Charles Church, 82, died unexpectedly Nov. 18, 2001.

Born in Warren, he had been a resident of the Akron area for most of his life. He served in the United States Army Air Force as a colonel during World War II, and was a POW in Europe. He was a graduate of the University of Akron and Akron Law School, and practiced law on East Market Street for over 40 years, retiring in 1991. Mr. Church was a member of the Tallmadge Lodge 756 F&AM, the Tadmor Shrine, the Akron Commandery, the Akron Bar Association, and the Confederate Air Force.



Preceded in death by his wife, Betty, in 1996, he is survived by his sons, Richard Jok Church of California, James Jared Church (Jan) of Washington, D.C., James Charles Collins and Richard Eugene Collins (Becky), both of Akron; daughter, Kathleen Marie Stull (Jeffrey) of Mogadore; grandchildren, Stacy, Christopher, Sean, Adam, and Hannah; three great-grandchildren; and special nephew, George Terhesh.
