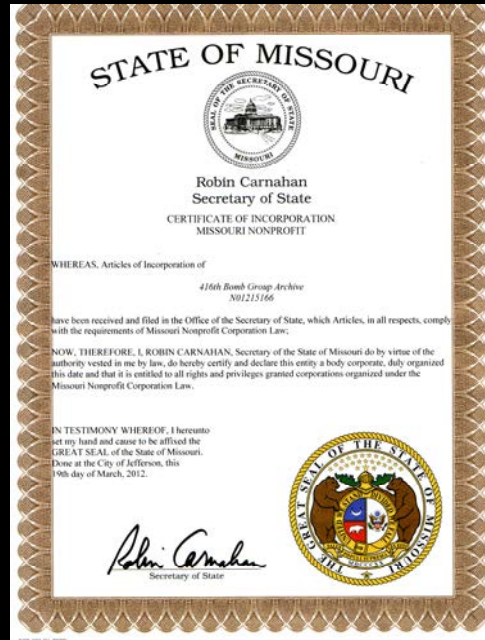

A letter from the Internal Revenue Service, Department of the Treasury, dated July 24, 2013.
